Any X in a box = that particular MMC/CCSS credit is *completely embedded* in the 1st year curriculum.

ELA 12 ½ = Half credit is completely embedded. Half credit ELA classes cover technical writing, *not* literature/novels. Technical writing includes portfolio pieces like resume, cover letter, follow up letter, research papers, writing assignments, etc.

ELA 12 ½ * = Health Tech II covers ½ ELA that includes literature. Therefore, a student who completes 1 year in Health Tech I or Dental *and* 1 year in Health Tech II will earn the FULL ELA 12 credit.

Agriscience offers ½ credit ELA portfolio year 1 and ½ credit ELA literature year 2, equaling a FULL credit

Science = Agriscience offers either a Science Elective or Biology credit.
